- 33,129 Unhoused Veterans (VA, 2022)
 - 683 in NC (that we know about)
- 1,400,000 Veterans at risk, or living in dismal conditions
- 160,000+ Servicemembers stationed overseas

Since 2008

- Directly impacted 126,463 Veterans and their loving, supporting families through our work.
- Provided 767 families with furniture and household goods, traveling 552,651 miles across North Carolina to pick up and deliver goods to 1,173 Veterans and their families.
- Completed 832 building projects providing independent living for 1,456 disabled Veterans and their families.
- Assisted 38,267 homeless Veterans through participation in 98 Veteran standdown events.
- Shipped over 83,000 care packages to our servicemen and women overseas consisting of 373,583 pounds of food and personal care items.
- Gifted 33,371 present to 2,420 children to ensure the children of our nation's heroes have a joyful holiday season.

Our programs benefit from 90% of all donations being directly applied to the needs of Veterans & their families.

Founded in 2008, Military Missions In Action assisted 126,463

Veterans and their family members by sending 90% of all donations directly to support our programs. We're dedicated to assisting Veterans in need, members of all Armed Forces, and their loving, supporting family members through three programs: Operation Building Hope, which provides creative home modification services and emergency repairs to ensure that Veterans and their family members with disabilities can live independently; Fill The Footlocker, which provides support to forward deployed servicemembers and military working dogs in addition to providing hygiene items, clothing, shoes, and blankets to unhoused Veterans; and Homes For Healing, which provides new and gently used household furnishings to assist Veterans, active-duty service members, and Veterans who were recently unhoused with securing housing stability.
